Kostas N. Fountas has earned his Medical Degree from the National and Capodistrian University of Athens, Greece. He has been subspecialized in functional neurosurgery after completing a fellowship at the Medical College of Georgia, Augusta, GA, USA. He was appointed in 2003 as Clinical Instructor at the Medical College of Georgia. He has joined the Faculty of Medicine, School of Health Sciences of the University of Thessaly, in Larisa, Greece since 2007. He has been Chairman and Director of the Department of Neurosurgery of the University Hospital of Larisa, since 2009.
